

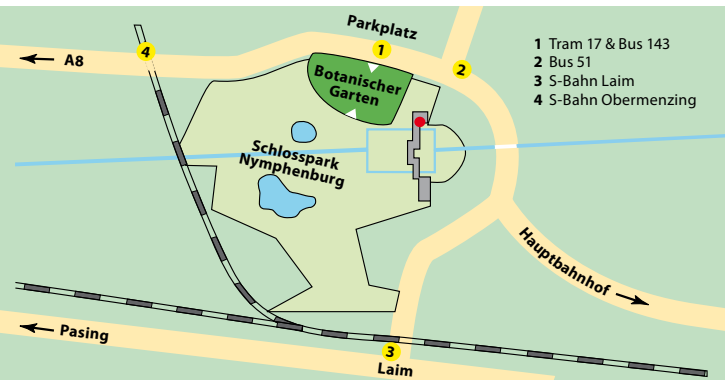

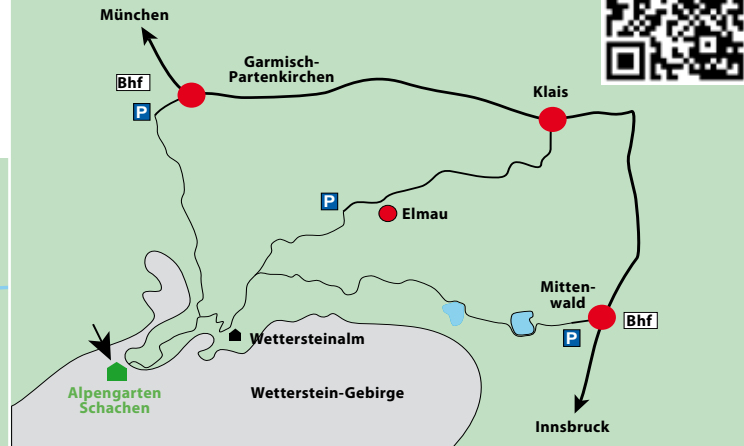

open from late June until early Sept.

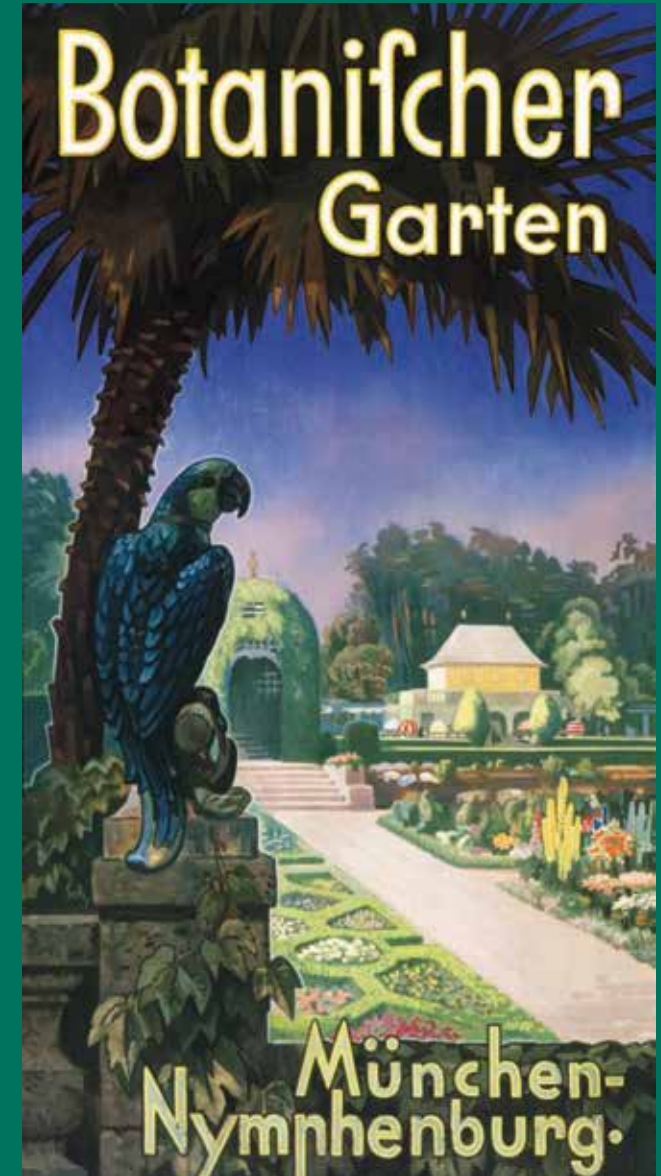


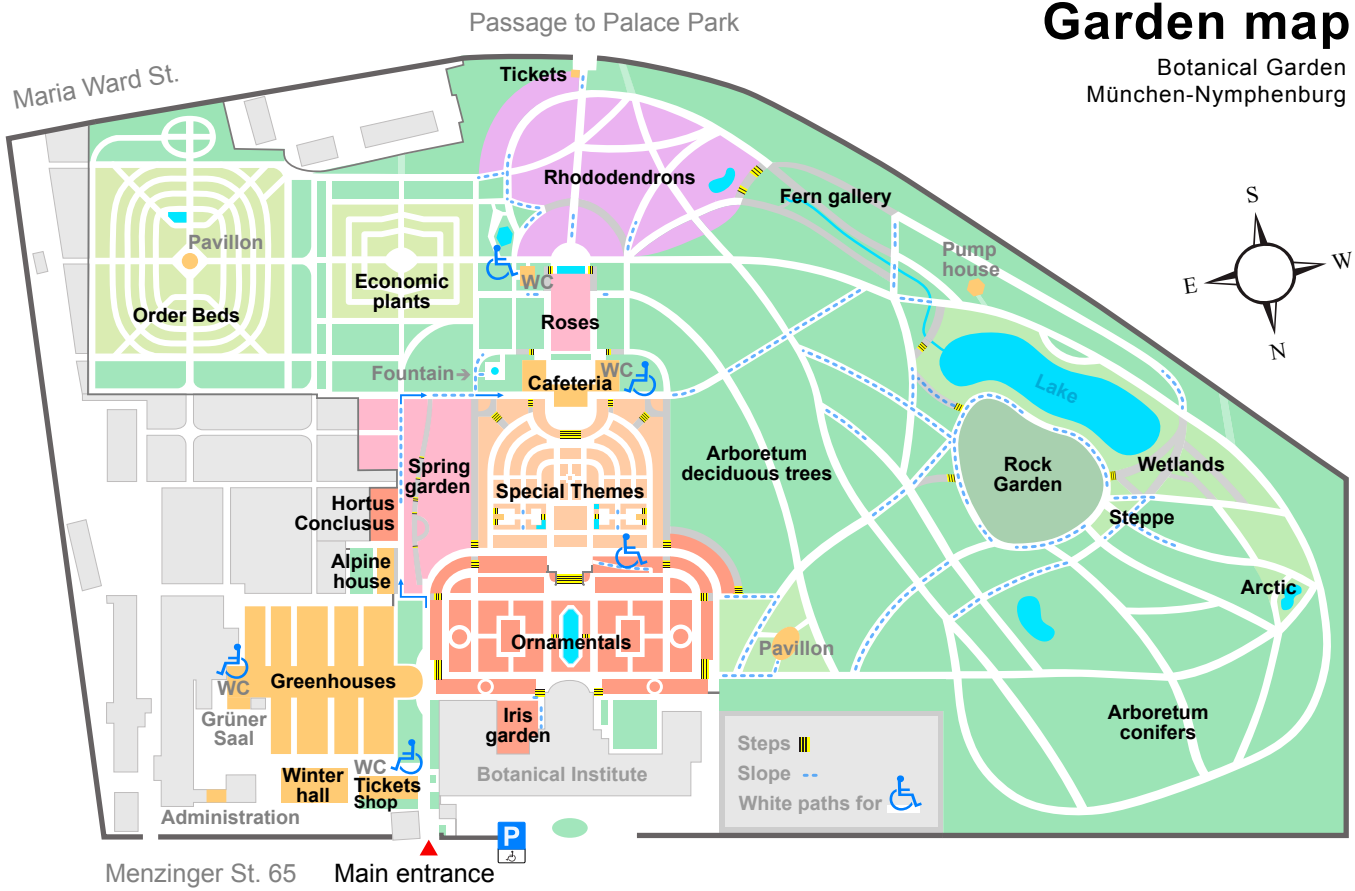

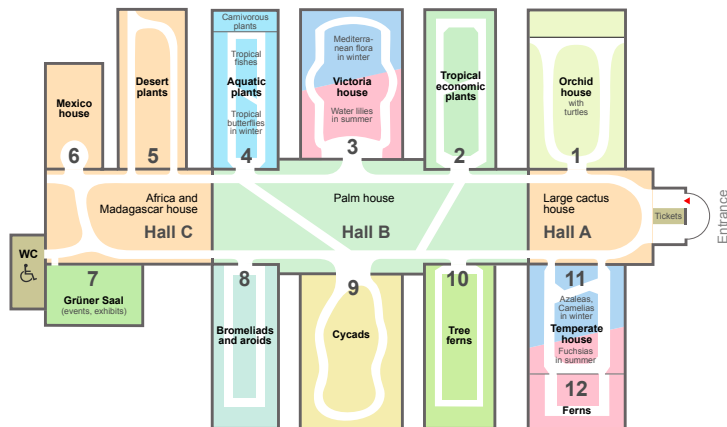
Garden plan
